Suggested Home activities:

1. Look around and see what how many different kinds of lights you have in your house..
2. Look in your kitchen & see which foods you like and don't like to eat.
3. When you're in the car talk about the things you can hear and how loud they are. Can you hear big trucks or trains as they pass? What about the radio – do you like music that's kind of loud?
