# PALS *Preschool Articulation and Language Skills*

March 30 & 31, 2015 Family Letter

Dear Family,

The emphasis in this lesson is on producing the correct number of syllables when speaking. The goal is to correctly produce 2-4 syllable words or phrases. The book for this lesson is ***Peanut Butter, Apple Butter, Cinnamon Toast*** by Argentina Palacios.

### Listening List-

Read this word list to your child. The goal is to model, or demonstrate, multisyllable words.

Elephant	Submarine
Umbrella	Cinnamon
Spaghetti	Pepperoni
Apple juice	Dinosaur

### Target Words

Look for these things and words in your home and community.

Banana	Swimming pool
Spiderman	Water bottle

Suggested Home activities:

1. Play with toy animals or action figures. Practice using 2 and 3 syllable words and phrases, such as “red dog”, “fish goes fast”.
2. With your child, look at what you’re wearing or what’s in your laundry basket. Take turns with your child with both of you saying a +color+ piece of clothing, such as “one red hat”, “two blue shoes”.
3. Nursery rhymes are a great source of funny words and phrases for speech practice. The rhythm of the rhymes often helps kids maintain the right number of syllables. Practice saying a few with your child like “Hickory Dickory Dock”, “Humpty Dumpty”, and “Patty Cake, Patty Cake, Baker’s Man”.
