Dear Family,

The emphasis in this lesson is on producing the /m/ sound in the middle of words. The book for this lesson is **Shark Trouble** by Sam Lloyd.

Listening List- Read this word list to your child. Slightly emphasize the /m /sound at the end of each word.

yummy tummy tomato	summer camel boomer	humming remote woman	timer comet zooming
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Target Words- Look for these thing and actions in your home and community.

lemon hammer	human eagle
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Suggested Home activities:

1. Practice humming songs with your child, instead of singing them. Try Happy Birthday , for example. How loud and soft can you be when you're humming
2. When you're in the car with your child identify when you are and are not "zooming" along. Talk about what may be happening that makes you go fast or slow in your car.
3. Talk with your child about what is and is not yummy. Also, what is and is not something to put in your tummy.
